Cor r igendum

1. Paragraph 38 (f)

The paragraph should read:

" (f) Sixth Committee

"Item 126 (Measures to prevent international terrorism which endanger8 or takes innocent human lives or jeopardizes fundamental freedoms and study of the underlying causes of those forms of terrorism and acts of violence which lie in misery, frustration, grievance and despair and which cause some people to sacritice human lives, including their own, in an attempt to effect radical changes)

"The General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item should be allocated to the Sixth Committee, on the underetanding that sub-item (b) (Convening, nder the auspices of the United Nations, of an international conference to define terrorism and to differentiate it from the struggle of peoples for national liberation) should first be introduced at one plenary meeting before its consideration by the Committee."

2. Paragraph 40, First Committee

Item 25 in the list of items allocated to the First Committee should read:

"25. Review of the implementation of the Declaration on the Strengthening of International Security (p. 73):

- "(a) Implementation of the Declaration on the Preparation of Societies for Life and Peace: report of the Secretary-General;
- Review of the implementation of the Declaration on the Strengthening of International Security: report of the Secretary-General."
