PROPOSED PROGRAMME BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM 1988-1989

Programme budget implications of the draft resolution
recommended by the First Committee (A/42/753, para. 8)Report of the Fifth CommitteeRapporteur: Mr. Felix ABOLY-BI-KOUASSI (Côte d'Ivoire)

1. At its 45th meeting, on 25 November 1987, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/42/43) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 8 of its report (A/42/753). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
