REVIEW AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CONCLUDING DOCUMENT OF THE TWELFTH SPECIAL SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Note by the Secretary-General

1. By a note of 24 February 1988 (S/19530), the Secretary-General brought to the attention of the members of the Security Council paragraphs 1 and 3 of General Assembly resolution 42/39 A of 30 November 1987, entitled "Review and implementation of the Concluding Document of the Twelfth Special Session of the General Assembly".
2. By a note verbale of 19 August 1988, the Permanent Mission of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to the United Nations conveyed to the Secretary-General its views in reference to General Assembly resolution 42/39 A.
3. By a letter of 12 October 1988, the Permanent Mission of the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic transmitted to the Secretary-General, in reference to General Assembly resolution 42/39 A, a note verbale on the question of the role of the Security Council in the field of disarmament.
4. By a letter dated 18 October 1988, addressed to the President of the Security Council, the Secretary-General requested him to bring to the attention of the members of the Security Council the contents of the two notes verbales mentioned in paragraphs 2 and 3 above.
5. By a letter of 28 October 1988, the President of the Security Council informed the Secretary-General that his letter of 18 October concerning General Assembly resolution 42/39 of 30 November 1987, as well as the attached notes verbales, had been circulated to the members of the Security Council.
