Letter dated 19 September 1990 rom the Permanent Representative of Pakistan to the United Nations addressed to he Secretary-General

Further to our 'etter dated 13 July 1990 (A/45/346-S/21395), I have the honour to inform you that on 17 September 1990 a strong protest was lodged with the Afghan Chargéd'affaires in Islamabad on the firing on 13 September 1990 of a Scud missile by Kabul forces, which landed in Pakistani territory near Shahdal in Kurram Agency, He was asked to inform his authorities that if such violations did not cease the entire responsibility for the serious consequences would rest on the Kabul authorities.

I request you to have the present letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under items 29, 71 and 144 of the provisional agenda, and of the Security Council.
