Reaffirming the **views set forth** in their previous communications of 5 June, 9 and 11 July, 21 and 26 November 1990 and 9 **and 28 May, 24** June and 16 July 1991, the **members** of the Permanent Commission for the South Pacific once **again** reject the continuation of nuclear testing by France in view of **th** grave **risk** such testing poses **to** the marine environment and to life in the Pacific basin, and again call **for** an immediate and permanent end to such **tests.**

## ANNEX

## Statement by the Permanent Commission for the South Pacific issued at Santiago on 16 July 1991

France **yesterday conducted** another nuclear test at Mururoa Atoll, the sixth this year, according to information provided by the French Ministry of **Defence.** 

In view **of** such a serious announcement, the secretariat of the Permanent Commission for the South Pacific (PCSP), faithful to its mandate and to the policy for the protection and **defence of** the marine environment and **sea** life adopted jointly by the Governments of Colombia, Chile, Ecuador and Peru as members of this regional maritime **organization**, reiterates its utter rejection of such tests and its strenuous protest against France's persistence in conducting them despite the **grave** risk they pose to the marine environment and its resources and the universal outcry of the peoples **of** the Pacific basin in general, and the member countries **of** the PCSP in particular, for the immediate and permanent cessation **of** such tests.
