ANNEX

Statement on the assassination of President Boudiaf, issued
by the Presidency of the Council of the European Economic
Community on 29 June 1992

The Presidency of the Council of the European Economic Community has noted with dismay the tragic events in Annaba, in particular the death of Mr. Mohammed Boudiaf, President of the High State Committee of Algeria.

The Presidency reiterates its firm condemnation of the use of violence, irrespective of its aims, and trusts that this regrettable event will not prejudice Algeria's pursuit of the democratic process.

The Presidency expresses its solidarity with the people of Algeria and recalls the wish of the European Economic Community, set out in the Declaration of the Lisbon European Council, to contribute to the stability and the prosperity of Algeria, in particular, and the Mediterranean region, in general.
