Letter dated 16 October 1992 from the Prime Minister of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia to the Secretary-General

As you know, I have long advocated placing the aircraft which remain in the hands of the Bosnian Serbs under United Nations control. Dr. Karadzic has proposed sending those aircraft to an airfield in Yugoslavia, where it would be easier for the United Nations to exercise control over their use. I wish to inform you of my Government's readiness to receive those aircraft at a Yugoslav airfield and to cooperate with the United Nations Protection Force in keeping them on the ground.

I request that this letter be distributed as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda item 69, and of the Security Council.

Once again, permit me to thank you for your continuing selfless and tireless efforts to restore peace to the Balkans.
