Analysis of the agenda of the General Assembly

Note by the Secretariat

I. Introduction

1. In section B, paragraph 5, of the annex to its resolution 58/126 of 19 December 2003, the General Assembly requested the President of the General Assembly:

“... to make proposals for the further biennialization, triennialization, clustering and elimination of items of the customary agenda of the Assembly for the consideration of the General Committee by 1 April 2004.”

2. At the request of the President, the Secretariat has prepared the present note to facilitate the deliberations on this matter.

3. The agenda of the General Assembly is an evolving document; new items and sub-items are added each session, titles of items change from session to session and items are dropped when they are no longer relevant.


4. This note has the following annexes:

5. There are in total 333 items and sub-items in the agenda. The numbers of items allocated to individual Main Committees and the plenary, as shown in the figure, are as follows:

6. Of the 333 items and sub-items in the agenda, the frequency of items is as follows:

- Annual items 229
- Biennial items 80
 - Even-numbered sessions 30
 - Odd-numbered sessions 50
- Triennial items 10
- Quadrennial items 10
- Quinquennial items 5

7. The lists of agenda items are derived from documents A/59/50, A/58/251, A/57/251/Rev.1, A/56/251/Rev.1 and A/55/251/Rev.1.

8. In the annexes, the columns "Session" and "Year" (see heading H) indicate when the item was included in the agenda and who requested it.

9. The "Action history" column (see heading I) contains information from the last session when the item was considered.

10. The column "No. of meetings" (see heading I) indicates how many meetings were allocated for the agenda item.

11. The number of speakers (see heading I) refers to the number for the last session the item was considered.

12. In the "No. of reports" column (see heading I), numbers in square brackets imply addenda and an asterisk means that a document was issued under several items.

13. The following items or sub-items are new and their frequency is not yet known. They are therefore identified as annual items.

- Prevention of armed conflict (plenary item)
- Compliance with arms limitation and disarmament and non-proliferation agreements (First Committee item)
- Improving the effectiveness of the methods of work of the First Committee (First Committee item)
- Confidence-building measures in the regional and subregional context (First Committee item).

II. Concluding observations

14. It is hoped that the factual information provided in this note will assist delegations in identifying ways to streamline the agenda of the General Assembly. For example, a review of the items of the plenary finds 10 items which can be considered to be "dormant", that is, items under which no substantive action has been taken for the past 10 years (see annex VII). The Assembly may wish to consider whether such items should remain on the agenda, but on an "inactive list", and to be reinstated on the "active agenda" when required. Dormant items are not so apparent among the items allocated to the Main Committees.

15. A step further could also be considered. As noted in A/58/CRP.4, there appears to be a mismatch between the agenda and the priorities of the Organization. Rather than trying to find a structure to house all items, should we not consider a list of agenda items that would conform to the priorities of the Organization as reflected in the medium-term plan or defined in the Millennium Declaration? One possible approach is to differentiate between a permanent agenda and an actual agenda for a particular session. The benefit would be to allow the actual agenda of each session to reflect the priorities of the United Nations at that time.

16. Annex II lists all annual items of the agenda of the General Assembly. This list could be examined for further biennialization, triennialization and, equally importantly, for clustering, so as to consolidate and enhance the debates on similar items. It should be noted that biennialization of items is not practised in all the Main Committees. The Fourth and Third Committees, for example, have annual items only.

17. Annex III, which lists all biennial items, could also be reviewed for the possibility of triennializing some of the items.
