At its 38th plenary meeting, on 20 October 2006, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee (A/61/250/Add.1), decided to consider directly in plenary meeting the following items in the agenda of its sixty-first session under heading I (Organizational, administrative and other matters):

155. Commemoration of the two-hundredth anniversary of the abolition of the trans-Atlantic slave trade.

156. Extension of the terms of the ad litem judges of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States between 1 January and 31 December 1994.
