## Letter dated 29 November 2006 from the Permanent Representative of Romania to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to transmit herewith the Bucharest Declaration on International Cooperation on Countering Terrorism, Corruption and Transnational Organized Crime, adopted at the Second Subregional Expert Workshop on International Cooperation on Counter-Terrorism and the Fight against Transnational Organized Crime (see annex).

The meeting was held in Bucharest from 13 to 15 November and was organized by the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime and the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe, with the support of the Stability Pact for South-Eastern Europe and of the Government of Romania. The meeting was a follow-up to the first meeting held in Zagreb from 7 to 9 March 2005.
