Pattern of conferences

Adoption of the draft biennial calendar of conferences and meetings for 2008-2009

Note by the Secretariat

1. The present document contains the draft biennial programme of conferences and meetings of the United Nations and shows meetings of organs of the United Nations, their subsidiary bodies, special conferences and expert groups. Conferences and meetings of the main legislative and executive bodies of the specialized agencies, the International Atomic Energy Agency and treaty bodies established under the auspices of the United Nations are also listed for information, with their dates and venues.

2. In considering the draft calendar for the biennium 2008-2009, the Committee on Conferences may wish to note the following meetings in particular:

2008

(a) Item 35, "United Nations Environment Programme, Governing Council/Global Ministerial Environment Forum, tenth special session". At its twenty-first session in 2001, the Governing Council decided, subject to the availability of an offer from a host country, to hold its session in alternate years in the United Nations regions, where possible, on a rotating basis, in keeping with the spirit of its decision 20/17 of 5 February 1999. The Government of Monaco has offered to host the tenth special session of the Governing Council from 20 to 22 February 2008;

(b) Item 60, "International Civil Service Commission, sixty-sixth session". In its resolution 40/243, section I, paragraph 4 (g), the General Assembly reaffirmed that the Commission should hold its regular annual session at United Nations Headquarters, and, if more than one session is required in any one year, may accept an invitation from one of its participating organizations to hold its other session or sessions at the headquarters of that particular organization. It is anticipated that the Commission will hold its fall 2008 session at the headquarters of one of the participating organizations so as to enable the members to familiarize themselves

with conditions at other duty stations and to establish contacts with members of legislative bodies of other organizations;

(c) Item 78, “United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, twelfth session”. In its resolution 60/184 of 22 December 2005, the General Assembly welcomed the generous offer by the Government of Ghana to host the twelfth session of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development in 2008 and expressed its gratitude to the African Union for its support for Ghana in this connection;

(d) Item 113, “Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions”. By part II, paragraph 2, of its resolution 1437 (XIV), the General Assembly authorized the Advisory Committee, in fulfilment of its functions under rule 157 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, to meet as it deems necessary and appropriate at the various offices of the United Nations and at the headquarters of the specialized agencies in order to advise the agencies on administrative and financial matters. In practice, the Advisory Committee has continued to meet outside New York along the lines authorized by the Assembly. The Advisory Committee may hold meetings at various United Nations duty stations and agencies located outside New York during May and June 2008;

(e) Item 149, “United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board, fifty-fifth session”. In its resolution 61/240, the General Assembly took note of the decision of the Board at its fifty-third session (see A/61/9, sect. II.B, para. 12) to revert to annual sessions as from 2007 with the aim of completing its work within five working days. It is anticipated that the Board will hold its next annual session in 2008 in Rome;

(f) Item 150, “United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board, Standing Committee”. The mandate of the Committee was amended by the Board in its decision made at its fifty-third session (see A/61/9, sect. II.B, para. 12). The Committee will continue to hold annual meetings, but of a shorter duration, during each session of the Board;

(g) Item 151, “Investments Committee”. One of the meetings of the Investments Committee is held in conjunction with the meeting of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board. The meetings of the Committee are usually held in New York except for the meeting with the Pension Board, which is held wherever the Board convenes. The Committee will hold a meeting in July 2008 in Rome in conjunction with the session of the Pension Board;

(h) Item 164, “Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean, thirty-second session”. In accordance with General Assembly resolution 40/243, section I, paragraph 4 (f), the decision to convene the thirty-second session of the Commission in Santo Domingo is subject to approval by the Assembly. The Economic and Social Council approved the decision at its substantive session of 2006 (see Council resolution 2006/40);

(i) Item 301, “Follow-up International Conference on Financing for Development to review the implementation of the Monterrey Consensus”. In its resolution 61/191, the General Assembly decided to hold the Conference in Doha in the second half of 2008, at a date to be determined by the General Assembly in consultation with the host country, taking into due consideration the regular schedule of meetings of the United Nations;

(j) Item 51, “International Civil Service Commission, sixty-eighth session”. In its resolution 40/243, section I, paragraph 4 (g), the General Assembly reaffirmed that the Commission should hold its regular annual session at United Nations Headquarters, and, if more than one session is required in any one year, may accept an invitation from one of its participating organizations to hold its other session or sessions at the headquarters of that particular organization. It is anticipated that the Commission will hold its fall 2009 session at the headquarters of one of the participating organizations so as to enable the members to familiarize themselves with conditions at other duty stations and to establish contacts with members of legislative bodies of other organizations;

(k) Item 185, “Eighteenth United Nations Regional Cartographic Conference for Asia and the Pacific”. The Conference was approved by the Economic and Social Council in its decision 2007/248, by which the Council approved the provisional calendar of conferences and meetings for 2008 and 2009 in the economic, social and related fields (E/2007/L.10). However, the Council decided to postpone the consideration of the item on cartography from its 2007 substantive session to a resumed session at a later date in 2007 (see decision 2007/268). Therefore, the dates of this conference are still subject to the final decision of the Council;

(l) Item 272, “Review Conference on the implementation of the Durban Declaration and Programme of Action”. In its resolution 61/149, the General Assembly decided to convene in 2009 a review conference on the implementation of the Durban Declaration and Programme of Action, to be conducted within the framework of the General Assembly.

3. The Committee’s attention is drawn to the subsidiary bodies of the Human Rights Council. In its decision 1/102 of 30 June 2006, the Human Rights Council decided to extend exceptionally for one year, subject to the review to be undertaken by the Council in conformity with General Assembly resolution 60/251, the mandates and the mandate holders of all the special procedures of the Commission on Human Rights, of the Subcommission on the Promotion and Protection of Human Rights, as well as the procedure established in accordance with Economic and Social Council resolution 1503 (XLVIII) (1503 procedure). By its resolution 5/1 of 18 June 2007, the Human Rights Council concluded the review of some of the above-mentioned subsidiary bodies and established four new subsidiary bodies: a Human Rights Council Advisory Committee to replace the Subcommission; a Working Group on Communications and a Working Group on Situations of the Council’s complaint procedure to replace those with the same titles of the former 1503 procedure; and a new Working Group on the Universal Periodic Review. The Human Rights Council Advisory Committee and the Working Group on the Universal Periodic Review are expected to hold their first meetings in 2008. The Council will decide at its sixth session, in September 2007, on the most appropriate mechanisms to continue the work of the Working Group on Indigenous Populations, the Working Group on Contemporary Forms of Slavery, the Working Group on Minorities and the Social Forum, which were subsidiary bodies of the former Subcommission. Also by its resolution 5/1, the Council renewed the mandates of the special procedures, including the following procedures, until the date on which they will be considered by the Council according to its annual programme of work:

- (a) Working Group of Experts on People of African Descent;
- (b) Working Group on Arbitrary Detention;
- (c) Working Group on Enforced or Involuntary Disappearances;
- (d) Working Group on the question of the use of mercenaries as a means of violating human rights and impeding the exercise of the right of peoples to self-determination.

4. The mandates of the following subsidiary bodies of the Human Rights Council, which are intergovernmental and not subject to the above-mentioned review process, have been renewed for different periods:

(a) Open-ended working group on an optional protocol to the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights (mandate renewed by Human Rights Council resolution 1/3 of 29 June 2006 for a period of two years);

(b) Intergovernmental Working Group on the Effective Implementation of the Durban Declaration and Programme of Action (mandate renewed by Human Rights Council resolution 1/5 of 30 June 2006 for a period of three years);

(c) Working Group on the Right to Development (mandate renewed by Human Rights Council resolution 4/4 of 30 March 2007 for a period of two years);

(d) High-level task force on the implementation of the right to development (mandate renewed by Human Rights Council resolution 4/4 of 30 March 2007 for a period of two years).

5. The Committee may wish to be further informed that in a decision adopted at its thirty-ninth session, held in New York from 23 July to 10 August 2007, the Committee on the Elimination of Discrimination against Women has requested the General Assembly to authorize it, as a permanent measure from 2008 onwards, to hold three annual sessions of three weeks each, with a one-week pre-session working group for each session, in order to implement all its responsibilities under article 18 of the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women in an effective and timely manner. The Committee has also requested that its Working Group on Communications under the Optional Protocol be granted the opportunity to meet three times a year instead of twice a year, for a total of 10 working days, immediately prior to or after the scheduled sessions of the Committee. The Committee has recommended that one of its three annual sessions be held at United Nations Headquarters in New York so as to facilitate and encourage ongoing cooperation between the Committee and the United Nations gender equality bodies. Pending approval of the Committee's request by the General Assembly, the draft biennial calendar of conferences and meetings for 2008 and 2009 reflects the existing mandate and entitlement of the Committee.

6. In its resolution 53/208 A of 18 December 1998, the General Assembly decided that United Nations bodies should be invited to avoid holding meetings on Orthodox Good Friday and that that arrangement should be taken into account when drafting future calendars of conferences and meetings. For the next biennium, Orthodox Good Friday occurs on 25 April in 2008 and on 17 April in 2009.
