# **Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly**

### **Report of the Special Political and Decolonization Committee** (Fourth Committee)

Rapporteur: Mr. Reniery Valladares-Gómez (Honduras)

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 21 September 2007, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-second session the item entitled "Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly" and to allocate it to all the Main Committees for the sole purpose of considering and taking action on their respective tentative programmes of work.

2. The Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee) considered the item at its 23rd meeting, on 14 November 2007 (see A/C.4/62/SR.23).

3. At the 23rd meeting, on 14 November, the Chairman drew the attention of the Committee to a conference room paper entitled "Draft provisional guidelines: approximate dates for the consideration of items by the Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee) at the sixty-third session of the General Assembly".

4. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted the draft provisional guidelines annexed to the present report.
