Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 19 September 2008, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-third session the item entitled “Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions”.

2. At its 16th meeting, on 7 November 2008, the Fifth Committee had before it the following documents:

(a) Note by the Secretary-General concerning the vacancies in the membership of the Committee on Contributions that would occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of six of its members on 31 December 2008 (A/63/102);

(b) Note by the Secretary-General containing the names of six persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment or reappointment to the Committee on Contributions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2009 (A/C.5/63/5).

3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Vyacheslav Anatolievich Logutov (Russian Federation), Richard Moon (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland), Hae-yun Park (Republic of Korea), Thomas Thomma (Germany), Courtney H. Williams (Jamaica) and Wu Gang (China) as members of the Committee on Contributions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2009 (see para. 4).
