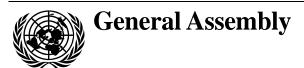

Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the International Civil Service Commission

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 19 September 2008, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-third session the item entitled "Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the International Civil Service Commission".
- 2. At its 16th meeting, on 7 November 2008, the Fifth Committee had before it the following documents:
- (a) Note by the Secretary-General concerning the vacancies in the membership of the International Civil Service Commission that would occur as a result of the expiration of the terms of office of five of its members on 31 December 2008 (A/63/104);
- (b) Note by the Secretary-General containing the names of persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment or reappointment to the Commission, to fill the following vacancies: two members from the African States, two members from the Asian States and one member from the Eastern European States (A/C.5/63/7).
- 3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly the appointment of Fatih Bouayad-Agha (Algeria), El Hassane Zahid (Morocco), Shamsher M. Chowdhury (Bangladesh), Wang Xiaochu (China) and Vladimir Morozov (Russian Federation) as members of the Commission for a four-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2009 (see para. 4).



Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

4. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly appoint the following persons as members of the International Civil Service Commission for a four-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2009:

Fatih Bouayad-Agha (Algeria)

Shamsher M. Chowdhury (Bangladesh)

Vladimir Morozov (Russian Federation)

Wang Xiaochu (China)

El Hassane Zahid (Morocco)
