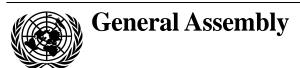

Chile

- 1. Chile has signed 16 universal counter-terrorism instruments, of which only the International Convention for the Suppression of Acts of Nuclear Terrorism, of 2005, remains to be ratified; this was approved by the National Congress on 28 July 2010.
- 2. Moreover, Chile has fully complied with the relevant resolutions on terrorism and non-proliferation adopted by the United Nations Security Council.
- 3. At the regional level, Chile is an active participant in the Organization of American States Inter-American Committee against Terrorism. Within the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) forum, Chile participates in and cooperates with all initiatives submitted to the APEC Counter-Terrorism Task Force.
- 4. Chile also participates in various policy initiatives in other areas, including, inter alia, the Global Initiative to Combat Nuclear Terrorism.
- 5. During the reporting period, there has not been any incident of international terrorism in Chile and no case concerning terrorism was prosecuted.
