I have the honour to request you to transmit to the General Assembly at its sixty-fifth session the following resolution (resolution 1999 (2011)) on the admission of the Republic of South Sudan to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 6582nd meeting on 13 July 2011:

The Security Council,

Having examined the application of the Republic of South Sudan for admission to the United Nations (A/65/900-S/2011/418),

Recommends to the General Assembly that the Republic of South Sudan be admitted to membership in the United Nations.

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the Council's provisional rules of procedure, I also request you to transmit to the General Assembly at its sixty-fifth session, for its information, the verbatim records of the 6580th and 6582nd meetings of the Security Council, at which the application of the Republic of South Sudan was considered.
