Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly

Report of the Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee)

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 20 September 2013, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-eighth session the item entitled “Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly” and to allocate it to all the Main Committees for the sole purpose of considering and taking action on their respective tentative programmes of work.
2. The Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee) considered the item at its 25th meeting, on 14 November 2013 (see [A/C.4/68/SR.25](#)).
3. At its 25th meeting, on 14 November, the Committee had before it a draft decision entitled “Proposed programme of work and timetable of the Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee) for the sixty-ninth session of the General Assembly” ([A/C.4/68/L.10](#)), submitted by the Bureau.
4. At the same meeting, the Chair orally revised the draft decision.
5. Also at the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision [A/C.4/68/L.10](#), as orally revised (see para. 6).
