Summary

The present report contains information received from Member States on their military expenditures for the latest fiscal year for which data are available. To date, the Secretary-General has received reports from 35 Governments.

I. Introduction

1. The General Assembly, in paragraph 1 of its resolution [68/23](#) called upon Member States to report annually to the Secretary-General on their military expenditures for the latest fiscal year for which data were available, using preferably and to the extent possible, one of the standardized reporting forms, including a “nil report” form, if appropriate.

II. Action taken by the Secretariat

2. On 28 February 2014, the Office for Disarmament Affairs requested Member States to submit their reports no later than 30 April 2014. The replies received are reproduced in section III below. Any additional reports received from Member States will be issued as an addendum to the present report.

3. In October 2013, the Secretariat launched a new online platform on military expenditures. The overhaul of the old database was recommended by the Group of Governmental Experts on the Operation and Further Development of the United Nations Standardized Instrument for Reporting Military Expenditures (see [A/66/89](#), para. 72 (i), and Corrs.1-3). All online information on military spending is now map-based, user-friendly and interactive, and contains an extensive resource section (www.un-arm.org/Milex/Home.aspx).

4. In addition, an online reporting system was developed, based on the instrument’s agreed standardized, simplified and “nil report” forms, which States can utilize depending on their preference and circumstances.

5. In 2013, out of a total of 58 States which submitted reports that year, 14 States (or 24 per cent) made use of the online reporting facility when submitting their report. In 2014, 20 out of a total of 35 States, or 57 per cent, submitted their reports online.

6. The Secretariat continues to organize side events and informal briefings to promote the United Nations Report on Military Expenditures and participation by Member States in the instrument, including during the meetings of the First Committee of the General Assembly, the United Nations Disarmament Commission and the Disarmament Fellowship Programme.

III. Replies received from Governments

Explanatory notes

7. To date, the Secretary-General has received reports from 35 Governments. A number of States provided clarifications and additional information on defence planning to explain their military expenditures, which are included in this report as well.

8. The originals of the replies from States, if received by means other than the online reporting system, are available from the Office for Disarmament Affairs.
