REQUEST FOR THE INCLUSION OF A SUPPLEMENTARY ITEM IN THE AGENDA OF THE TWENTY-THIRD SESSION

REPORT OF THE INTERNATIONAL COURT OF JUSTICE

Note by the Secretary-General

The Secretary-General has the honour to request, under rule 14 of the rules of procedure, the inclusion in the agenda of the twenty-third regular session of the General Assembly of a supplementary item entitled: "Report of the International Court of Justice".

In accordance with rule 20 of the rules of procedure, an explanatory memorandum is attached.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- 1. The President of the International Court of Justice has informed the Secretary-General that the Court, conscious of the need for closer co-operation with the other organs of the United Nations, has drawn up a report on its activities from 1 August 1967 to 31 July 1968 and wishes to submit this report to the General Assembly at its next regular session. The International Court of Justice feels that such a report, the first of its kind, would contribute to a better understanding of its functions and of its activities within the framework of the United Nations.
- 2. Rule 13 (b) of the Assembly's rules of procedure provides that the provisional agenda of a regular session of the General Assembly shall include <u>inter alia</u> the reports of the International Court of Justice. However, since the communication from the President of the Court was received after the publication of the provisional agenda, the Secretary-General has the honour to propose the inclusion in the agenda of the twenty-third session of a supplementary item entitled "Report of the International Court of Justice" in accordance with rule 14 of the rules of procedure.
- 3. The report of the International Court of Justice will be communicated to Members of the General Assembly in document A/7217.
