Addendum

- 1. The Secretary-General has received notification of the resignation of Yoon Seongmee (Republic of Korea) from the Committee on Contributions, effective 4 April 2019. Accordingly, the General Assembly will be required to appoint, at its current session, a person to fill the vacancy for the remaining period of the term of office of Ms. Yoon, which expires on 31 December 2020.
- 2. The Government of the Republic of Korea has nominated Na Sang-deok to fill the vacancy arising from the resignation of Ms. Yoon.
- 3. In a communication dated 16 April 2019, the Secretariat was informed by the Chair of the Group of Asia-Pacific States that the candidature of Mr. Na had been endorsed by the Group.
