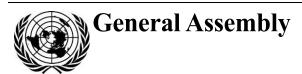

For the existing text substitute

22. The report of this mandate on Nazism, neo-Nazism and related intolerance, presented to the General Assembly at its seventy-third session, focuses on racist expression online, which is where many incidents of racist and xenophobic speech also occur. For example, in January 2018 the World Jewish Congress recorded that anti-Semitic posts on social media, including Holocaust denialism, had risen by close to 30 per cent compared with the same period in 2016.
