Addendum

1. The Secretary-General has received notification of the resignation of Sang-deok Na (Republic of Korea) from the Committee on Contributions, effective 26 February 2020. Accordingly, the General Assembly will be required to appoint, at its current session, a person to fill the vacancy for the remaining period of the term of office of Mr. Na, which expires on 31 December 2020.

2. The Government of the Republic of Korea has nominated Ji-sun Jun to fill the vacancy arising from the resignation of Mr. Na.

3. In a communication dated 6 March 2020, the Secretariat was informed by the Chair of the Group of Asia-Pacific States that the candidature of Ms. Jun had been endorsed by the Group.
