Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly

Report of the First Committee

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 20 September 2019, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to allocate item 121 to all the Main Committees for the purpose of discussing their working methods, as well as considering and taking action on their respective tentative programmes of work.
2. The First Committee considered the item at its 27th meeting, on 8 November 2019.¹
3. At the same meeting, the Chair made a statement and introduced the provisional programme of work and timetable of the First Committee for 2020.
4. Also at the same meeting, the Committee adopted its provisional programme of work and timetable for 2020, as set out in the annex to the present report.

^c During thematic discussions, delegations are encouraged to limit their statements to a maximum of 5 minutes; statements on behalf of a group of countries should not exceed 7 minutes.
