# Review of the efficiency of the administrative and financial functioning of the United Nations

#### **Report of the Fifth Committee**

### I. Introduction

1. The previous recommendations made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 133 are set out in the report of the Committee contained in document A/74/616.

2. During the second part of the resumed seventy-fourth session, the Fifth Committee met online owing to the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic, during which it resumed its consideration of the item.

## II. Consideration of draft decision A/C.5/74/L.54

3. On 2 July 2020, the Chair of the Committee submitted for consideration under silence procedure, in accordance with General Assembly decisions 74/544 and 74/555, a draft decision entitled "Questions deferred for future consideration" (A/C.5/74/L.54).

4. On 7 July, the Committee considered draft decision A/C.5/74/L.54 adopted, in accordance with the process set out in decisions 74/544 and 74/555 (see para. 5). It also noted that it would take note of the decision at its next meeting held after the cessation of the precautionary measures as soon as the circumstances allowed.
