Building a peaceful and better world through sport and the Olympic ideal

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution [74/16](#) of 9 December 2019, in which it urged Member States to observe the Olympic Truce individually and collectively, within the framework of the Charter of the United Nations, throughout the period from the seventh day before the start of the Games of the XXXII Olympiad until the seventh day following the end of the XVI Paralympic Games,

Noting that, owing to the coronavirus disease (COVID-19), the Games of the XXXII Olympiad were rescheduled to be held from 23 July to 8 August 2021 and that the XVI Paralympic Games were rescheduled to be held from 24 August to 5 September 2021, in Tokyo,

(a) Decides to observe the Olympic Truce throughout the period from the seventh day before the start of the Games of the XXXII Olympiad until the seventh day following the end of the XVI Paralympic Games, to be held in Tokyo in 2021;

(b) Also decides to include in the provisional agenda of its seventy-fifth session the sub-item entitled “Building a peaceful and better world through sport and the Olympic ideal” of the item entitled “Sport for development and peace”.
