Expenses incurred and reimbursement received by the United Nations in connection with assistance provided to the International Criminal Court

Report of the Secretary-General

Summary

The present report is submitted pursuant to General Assembly resolution [74/6](#), in which the Assembly emphasized the need for the Secretary-General to inform the Assembly at its seventy-fifth session of the expenses incurred and reimbursements received by the United Nations in connection with assistance provided to the International Criminal Court.

1. During the period from 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2020, the United Nations provided facilities and services to the International Criminal Court in the amount of \$946,157. The facilities and services included costs for staff who worked exclusively on matters pertaining to the Court, field security and malicious acts insurance policy premiums and fees, conference and related services, library services, the financial disclosure programme, language interpretation services and language proficiency examination registration fees.
2. Additional expenses in the amount of \$308,018 were incurred for services provided to the Court during the same period by the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in Mali, the United Nations Office at Geneva, the Economic Commission for Africa, the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in the Central African Republic and the International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals.
3. The Court regularly reimbursed the United Nations upon receipt of invoices.
4. Itemized details of the facilities and services provided to the Court by the United Nations during the period from 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2020 are provided in annex I, and to the Court by various offices away from Headquarters for the same period in annex II.
