Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. The previous recommendation made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 120 (e) is set out in the report of the Committee contained in document [A/75/583](#).
2. The Fifth Committee resumed its consideration of the item at its 8th meeting, on 30 December 2020. The Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General ([A/75/105/Rev.1/Add.1](#)) concerning a vacancy in the membership of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee. By that note, the Committee was informed of the nomination by the Government of South Africa and the endorsement by the Group of African States of Imran Vanker (South Africa) to fill that vacancy.
3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Mr. Vanker as a member of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2021 (see para. 4).

Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

4. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly appoint Imran Vanker (South Africa) as a member of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2021.
