Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly

Report of the Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee)

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 17 September 2021, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-sixth session the item entitled "Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly" and to allocate it to all the Main Committees for the sole purpose of considering and taking action on their respective tentative programmes of work.

2. The Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee) considered the item at its 16th meeting, on 11 November 2021.¹

3. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it a note by the Secretariat on the revitalization of the work of the General Assembly (A/C.4/76/INF/4).
