

Election of the Executive Director of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. The General Assembly, in its resolution 56/206 of 21 December 2001, decided to transform the United Nations Centre for Human Settlements into the secretariat of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat). In the same resolution, the Assembly also decided that the secretariat of UN-Habitat should be headed by an Executive Director at the level of Under-Secretary-General, to be elected by the Assembly for a term of four years upon nomination by the Secretary-General after consultation with Member States.
- 2. On 22 December 2017, the General Assembly, in its decision 72/413, approved the proposal of the Secretary-General to elect Maimunah Mohd Sharif (Malaysia) as Executive Director of UN-Habitat, at the Under-Secretary-General level, for a term of office of four years. Ms. Sharif took up her duties on 20 January 2018 and, accordingly, her term of office will end on 19 January 2022.
- 3. In the light of the provisions of resolution 56/206, the Secretary-General proposes to the General Assembly that the term of office of Ms. Sharif as Executive Director of UN-Habitat be extended for two years, from 20 January 2022 to 19 January 2024.
- 4. The Secretary-General trusts that the Assembly will approve the term extension.
