Seventy-sixth session Agenda item 23 (a) Groups of countries in special situations: follow-up to the Fourth United Nations Conference on the Least Developed Countries

Draft decision submitted by the President of the General Assembly*

Fifth United Nations Conference on the Least Developed Countries

The General Assembly, recalling its resolutions 73/242 of 20 December 2018 and 74/232 A of 19 December 2019 and its decision to convene the Fifth United Nations Conference on the Least Developed Countries at the highest possible level, including Heads of State and Government, recalling also its resolution 74/232 B of 11 August 2020, in which it decided to reschedule the Conference and to hold it in Doha from 23 to 27 January 2022, and noting with concern the situation concerning the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic and its unprecedented impacts, decides to further postpone the Conference to a date to be decided at the earliest possible time.
