## Offers by Member States of study and training facilities for inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories

### Report of the Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee)

## I. Introduction

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 16 September 2022, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-seventh session the item entitled “Offers by Member States of study and training facilities for inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories” and to allocate it to the Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee).
2. At its 1st meeting on 29 September 2022, the Fourth Committee decided to hold a general debate on decolonization items (agenda items 51 to 55). The general debate on those items was held at the 2nd, 7th, 8th and 9th meetings, on 3, 11, 13 and 14 October.
3. At its 9th meeting, on 14 October, the Committee took action on item 54. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee’s consideration of the items are reflected in the relevant summary records.<sup>1</sup>
4. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the report of the Secretary-General ([A/77/67](#)).

## II. Consideration of draft resolution [A/C.4/77/L.2](#)

5. At the 9th meeting, on 14 October, the Chair drew the attention of the Committee to a draft resolution entitled “Offers by Member States of study and training facilities for inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories” ([A/C.4/77/L.2](#)), submitted by Algeria, Argentina, Cuba, Ecuador, El Salvador, Greece, Iraq, Oman, Singapore, Slovenia, South Africa, Thailand, Uruguay and Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of).

Subsequently, the following countries joined in sponsoring the draft resolution: Azerbaijan, Bolivia (Plurinational State of), Eritrea, Fiji, Namibia, Panama, Papua New Guinea and Syrian Arab Republic<sup>2</sup>.

6. At the same meeting, the Committee was informed that the draft resolution had no programme budget implications.

7. Also at the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft resolution [A/C.4/77/L.2](#) without a vote (see para. 8).

### III. Recommendation of the Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee)

8. The Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee) recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

#### **Offers by Member States of study and training facilities for inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories**

*The General Assembly,*

*Recalling* its resolution [76/88](#) of 9 December 2021,

*Having examined* the report of the Secretary-General,<sup>1</sup> prepared pursuant to its resolution [845 \(IX\)](#) of 22 November 1954,

*Conscious* of the importance of promoting the educational advancement of the inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories,

*Strongly convinced* that the continuation and expansion of offers of scholarships is essential in order to meet the increasing need of students from Non-Self-Governing Territories for educational and training assistance, and considering that students in those Territories should be encouraged to avail themselves of such offers,

1. *Takes note* of the report of the Secretary-General;
2. *Expresses its appreciation* to those Member States that have made scholarships available to the inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories;
3. *Invites* all States to make or continue to make generous offers of study and training facilities to the inhabitants of those Territories that have not yet attained self-government or independence and, wherever possible, to provide travel funds to prospective students;
4. *Urges* the administering Powers to take effective measures to ensure the widespread and continuous dissemination in the Territories under their administration of information relating to offers of study and training facilities made by States and to provide all the facilities necessary to enable students to avail themselves of such offers;
5. *Requests* the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly at its seventy-eighth session on the implementation of the present resolution;
6. *Draws the attention* of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples to the present resolution.
