Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members and alternate members of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 16 September 2022, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-seventh session the item entitled “Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members and alternate members of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.

2. At its 11th meeting, on 4 November 2022, the Fifth Committee had before it the following documents:

(a) Note by the Secretary-General concerning a vacancy in the membership of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee that had occurred as a result of the resignation of Yamaguchi Tomoya (Japan), effective 29 August 2022 ([A/77/107](#));

(b) Note by the Secretary-General informing the Committee that the Government of Japan had nominated Yamada Jun for appointment to the United Nations Staff Pension Committee for the remaining period of the term of office of Mr. Yamaguchi, which expires on 31 December 2024 ([A/C.5/77/10](#)).

3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Mr. Yamada as a member of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee for a term of office beginning on _____¹ and ending on 31 December 2024 (see para. 4).
