

### Adoption of the draft calendar of conferences and meetings of the United Nations for 2022

#### Note by the Secretariat

- 1. The present document contains the draft calendar of conferences and meetings of the United Nations, which includes meetings of organs of the United Nations, their subsidiary bodies, special conferences and expert groups (see annex). Conferences and meetings of the main legislative and executive bodies of the specialized agencies, the International Atomic Energy Agency and treaty bodies established under the auspices of the United Nations are also listed for information.
- 2. In General Assembly resolution 72/266 A, the Assembly approved the change from a biennial to an annual budget cycle on a trial basis, beginning with the programme budget for 2020, and in resolution 3491 (XXX) it decided that the cycle of meetings and conferences should coincide with the budgetary period.
- 3. After review by the Committee on Conferences at its substantive session, the draft calendar will be included in the report of the Committee to the General Assembly, together with any updates and/or comments.
- 4. In the preparation of the draft calendar, due regard has been taken of General Assembly resolution 53/208, in particular its paragraph 11, and paragraphs 5 and 6 of Assembly resolution 75/244, in which it was decided that United Nations bodies should be invited to avoid holding meetings on Orthodox Good Friday, Yom Kippur, the Day of Vesak, Diwali, Gurpurab, Orthodox Christmas and Nowruz and that these arrangements should be taken into account when drafting future calendars of conferences and meetings. In 2022, these days occur on the dates set out in the table below, pending final confirmation from the Office of Human Resources of the Secretariat.
