

Moratorium on the use of the death penalty

Replace the first preambular paragraph with the following:

Guided by the purposes and principles contained in the Charter of the United Nations, including Article 1, paragraph 3, on achieving international cooperation in solving international problems of an economic, social, cultural or humanitarian character, and in promoting and encouraging respect for human rights and for fundamental freedoms for all without distinction as to race, sex, language, or religion, while recalling, in particular, Article 2, paragraph 7, which stipulates that nothing in the Charter shall authorize the United Nations to intervene in matters which are essentially within the domestic jurisdiction of any State,
