## The General Assembly,

*Having considered* the report of the Committee for Programme and Coordination on the work of its fifty-ninth session,<sup>1</sup> the reports of the Secretary-General on the proposed programme budget for 2020: part I, plan outline,<sup>2</sup> and part II, programme plan for programmes and subprogrammes and programme performance information,<sup>3</sup> and the letter dated 10 June 2019 from the Permanent Representative of the Syrian Arab Republic to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General,<sup>4</sup>

*Decides* to delete all narratives and references regarding the International, Impartial and Independent Mechanism to Assist in the Investigation and Prosecution of Persons Responsible for the Most Serious Crimes under International Law Committed in the Syrian Arab Republic since March 2011 from programme 6, Legal affairs, of the proposed programme budget for 2020.<sup>5</sup>
