STATUS OF CONVENTIONS

### Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. At its thirteenth session the Commission decided that it would consider, at each of its sessions, the status of conventions that were the outcome of work carried out by it. \*
- 2. The present note is submitted pursuant to that decision. The annex hereto sets forth the state of signatures, ratifications and accessions as at 25 March 1983 to the following conventions: Convention on the Limitation Period in the International Sale of Goods (New York, 1974); Protocol amending the Convention on the Limitation Period in the International Sale of Goods (Vienna, 1980); United Nations Convention on the Carriage of Goods by Sea, 1978 (Hamburg); and United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods (Vienna, 1980).
