
Status of conventions and model laws

Note by the Secretariat*

- 1. At its thirteenth session, in 1980, the United Nations Commission on International Trade Law (UNCITRAL) decided that it would consider, at each of its sessions, the status of conventions that were the outcome of work carried out by it.
- 2. The present note sets forth the status of the conventions and model laws emanating from the work of the Commission. It also shows the status of the Convention on the Recognition and Enforcement of Foreign Arbitral Awards,² which, although adopted prior to the establishment of the Commission, is closely related to the work of the Commission in the area of international commercial arbitration.
- 3. Technical cooperation and assistance activities aimed at promoting the use and adoption of its texts are priorities for UNCITRAL pursuant to a decision taken at its twentieth session (1987).³ The Secretariat monitors adoption of model laws and conventions. UNCITRAL texts also include legislative and legal guides and contractual standards whose impact this method cannot easily assess.⁴
- 4. This note indicates the changes since 26 May 2010, when the last annual report in this series (A/CN.9/694) was issued. The information contained herein is current up to 4 May 2011. Information on the status of conventions and model laws
