Having considered the reports of the Secretary-General³⁸ and of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions³⁹ on the question of the classification of United Nations Headquarters in the schedule of post adjustments established under that resolution,

Decides that, with effect from 1 January 1959, the post adjustment for United Nations Headquarters in New York shall be class 6 within the established system.

1343 (XIII). Agreement between the United Nations and the Carnegie Foundation concerning the use of the premises of the Peace Palace at The Hague

The General Assembly,

Considering that the contribution payable by the International Court of Justice in respect of the use of the Peace Palace under the terms of article II of the Agreement between the United Nations and the Carnegie Foundation concerning the use of the premises of the Peace Palace at The Hague as contained in annex A to General Assembly resolution 84 (I) of 11 December 1946, as amended by the Supplementary Agreement

contained in the annex to General Assembly resolution 586 (VI) of 21 December 1951, is no longer sufficient to defray the costs which the Carnegie Foundation is required to pay under the terms of the said Agreement, as amended.

Approves the Supplementary Agreement between the United Nations and the Carnegie Foundation concerning the use of the Peace Palace at The Hague as set forth in the annex to the present resolution.

ANNEX

SUPPLEMENTARY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE CARNEGIE FOUNDATION CONCERNING THE USE OF THE PEACE PALACE AT THE HAGUE

1. The United Nations and the Carnegie Foundation hereby agree that article II of the Agreement between the United Nations and the Carnegie Foundation concerning the use of the premises of the Peace Palace at The Hague as contained in annex A to General Assembly resolution 84 (I) of 11 December 1946, as amended by the Supplementary Agreement contained in the annex to Assembly resolution 586 (VI) of 21 December 1951, shall be amended to read as follows:

"Article II

"The annual contribution payable by the International Court of Justice in respect of the use of the Peace Palace is hereby fixed at 100,000 Netherlands florins net."

2. This Supplementary Agreement shall enter into force with effect from 1 January 1959.
