## RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

48/228. <u>Questions relating to the programme budget for the biennium 1994-1995</u>\*

## The General Assembly

1. <u>Authorizes</u> the Secretary-General to enter into commitments for the establishment of four temporary posts in an amount not to exceed 1,140,000 United States dollars for the period from 1 April 1994 to 31 December 1995;

2. <u>Also authorizes</u> the Secretary-General to enter into commitments in an amount not to exceed 130,000 dollars for the period from 1 April to 30 June 1994 in connection with non-post requirements pending the submission by the Secretary-General of the report requested by the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions in its report.  $\underline{1}/$
