- 2. <u>Endorses</u> the recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions contained in paragraph 8 of its related report, <u>2</u>/ and requests the Secretary-General to include in his report to be submitted to the General Assembly at its forty-ninth session on the procedures and norms for the creation, suppression, reclassification, conversion and redeployment of posts his views on how the current procedures could be changed to achieve the objectives outlined in the report of the Advisory Committee;
