

- C: Nuclear materials as in B but reworked into non-sensitive form
- D: New nuclear material produced (from reprocessing of spent fuel under safeguards, from enrichment of source material or obtained from material declared as excess)
- E: Nuclear material already under safeguards (spent fuel)
- F: Source material
