

Dear ASEAN Secretary-General,

The dialogue on disarmament is key to violence prevention, global peace and sustainable development as highlighted in the United Nation Secretary General's new disarmament agenda launched in Geneva in May 2018. Many disarmament and arms control meetings take place in Geneva. Because of this, Geneva is an international centre of disarmament diplomacy and home to international organizations, think-tanks and non-governmental organizations on disarmament.

The ASEAN Committee in Geneva (ACG) plays an active role in contributing to the disarmament discussions in Geneva, in particular to promote and advocate for ASEAN's objectives on disarmament and arms control. In this regard, as the Chair of ACG, I wish to invite you or your representative to deliver a special plenary address at the Conference on Disarmament (CD) on 25 June 2019 in order to share ASEAN experiences and views on non-proliferation and disarmament issues, including the contribution of SEANWFZ Treaty—a strategic instrument for peace and security in the region—to the global disarmament and non-proliferation regime. In the context that CD members have been putting more efforts and new initiatives in order to move forward the disarmament discussion this year, your presence will raise ASEAN awareness among the disarmament community in Geneva and positively contribute to Viet Nam's CD Presidency during 24 June and 18 August 2019.

In the role of the CD President, Viet Nam is pleased to ensure financial support for your participation in the Conference, including airfare and accommodation.
