At its 10th meeting, on 28 April 2006, the Commission recommended to the Economic and Social Council the approval of a revised draft resolution for adoption by the General Assembly entitled “Strengthening the United Nations Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice Programme and the role of the Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice as its governing body” (E/CN.15/2006/L.12/Rev.1), sponsored by Albania, Algeria, Australia, Austria (on behalf of the European Union), Bulgaria, Canada, China, Croatia, Ecuador, Egypt, Japan, Liechtenstein, the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Morocco, Nigeria, Norway, Oman, the Republic of Korea, Romania, Switzerland, the Syrian Arab Republic, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Turkey, Ukraine and the United States.
