Annotations

1. Election of the Bureau

Rule 18 of the rules of procedure of the Economic and Social Council provides that, each year at the commencement of its first meeting, the Council shall elect a President and four Vice-Presidents from among the representatives of its members. The membership of the Council in 2007 is given in the annex below. According to the equitable geographical rotation of the office of President among the regional groups, the President for 2007 should be the representative of a member of the Eastern European States group. The four Vice-Presidents of the Council shall be elected on the basis of equitable geographical distribution from the regional groups, excluding that to which the President belongs.

The President and Vice-Presidents shall constitute the Bureau. The Council, upon the recommendation of the President, shall decide on the special responsibilities of each of the Vice-Presidents.

Pursuant to Council resolution 1988/77, a meeting of the Council will be held on 17 January 2007 for the election of the Bureau.

2. Adoption of the agenda and other organizational matters

Rule 13 of the rules of procedure of the Council provides that, at the beginning of each session, after the election of the Bureau when required under rule 18, the Council shall adopt the agenda for the session.

The present provisional agenda has been prepared in conformity with the provisions of General Assembly resolution 48/162 and of other relevant legislative decisions, including, in particular, the provisions of Assembly resolutions 50/227 and 61/16.

In its decision 2006/263, the Council decided to defer consideration of the draft annex on the privileges and immunities of the specialized agencies with respect to the World Tourism Organization to its organizational session for 2007.

High-level segment

Focus of the 2007 thematic discussion and theme for the 2007 annual ministerial review

The Council's attention is drawn to General Assembly resolution 61/16 on the strengthening of the Economic and Social Council, whereby the Council would hold a thematic discussion on a theme from economic, social and related fields, and annual ministerial-level substantive reviews as part of its high-level segment.

In its decision 2006/274, the Council decided to defer consideration of the focus of the 2007 thematic discussion and the theme for the 2007 annual ministerial review to the first meeting of its organizational session for 2007.

Coordination segment of the Council

In its decision 2006/274, the Council decided that the coordination segment of its substantive session of 2007 would be devoted to consideration of the following theme: "The role of the United Nations system in promoting full and productive employment and decent work for all".

3. Basic programme of work of the Council

In accordance with rule 8 of the rules of procedure of the Council, the Council shall draw up, at its organizational session, with the assistance of the Secretary-General, its basic programme of work for the year.

The Council will have before it the proposed basic programme of work of the Council for 2007 and 2008 (E/2007/1) prepared by the Secretariat in accordance with the relevant decisions of the Council and of the General Assembly.

The Council's attention is drawn to General Assembly resolution 52/12 B, by which the Assembly decided to create a humanitarian affairs segment of the Council. In accordance with Council decision 1999/208, the Council, at its organizational session, may wish to select a theme for the humanitarian affairs segment of its substantive session of 2007.

Pursuant to Council decision 1982/174 on the rationalization of the work of the Council, the Council decided to identify, at its annual organizational session, a subject relating to interregional cooperation, of common interest to all regions, for detailed consideration under the agenda item on regional cooperation, and to request the executive secretaries of the regional commissions to submit their joint recommendations in that regard to the Council at its annual organizational session.

Pursuant to Council resolution 1988/77 on the revitalization of the Council, the President, prior to the organizational session, and with the cooperation of the other members of the Bureau, will arrange for consultations with members of the Council on the draft programme of work and provisional agenda prepared by the Secretary-General and make proposals thereon for consideration by the Council.

Pursuant to Council decision 2006/206 on adapting the work of the Economic and Social Council, the President of the Council will convene consultations, on an as-available basis, to adapt its organization of work, agenda and current methods of work in pursuance of paragraphs 155 and 156 of the World Summit Outcome and the related provisions of General Assembly resolution 61/16, with a view to implementation beginning in 2007.
