

Note by the Secretariat

To reflect the impact of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic on crime and criminal justice, the Secretariat prepared a working paper for the attention of the Fourteenth United Nations Congress on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice presenting the state of knowledge on developments in crime prevention and criminal justice trends as a result of the pandemic (A/CONF.234/15).
