REPORT OF THE DRAFTING SUB-COMMITTEE, CONSISTING OF THE REPRESENTATIVES OF CHINA, FRANCE AND THE UNITED KINGDOM, ON ARTICLE 11 OF THE DRAFT INTERNATIONAL DECLARATION ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Every one shall have the right to seek and may be granted asylum from persecution. The United Nations is bound to secure this asylum in agreement with Member States.

Prosecutions genuinely arising from non-political crimes or from acts contrary to the purposes and principles of the United Nations do not constitute persecution.
