Annotations

1. Election of officers

Rule 15 of the rules of procedure of the functional commissions of the Economic and Social Council stipulates that, at the commencement of the first meeting of a regular session, the Commission shall elect from among the representatives of its members a Chair, one or more Vice-Chairs and such other officers as may be required. Following the established practice, the Commission shall elect a Chair and four Vice-Chairs and also designate one of the Vice-Chairs as Rapporteur.

In subparagraph (c) of its decision 2002/210, the Economic and Social Council decided that, immediately following the closure of a regular session, the Commission for Social Development would hold the first meeting of its subsequent regular session for the sole purpose of electing the new Chair and other members of the Bureau. In its resolution 2014/3, the Council reaffirmed that the officers elected to the Bureau of the Commission should continue to be elected for a term of office of two years, in parallel with the review and policy cycle of 2015-2016. Accordingly, the Commission held the first meeting of its fifty-fourth session on 13 February 2015, immediately following the closure of the fifty-third session, and elected by acclamation Luz Andujar (Dominican Republic) as Vice-Chair.

Subsequently, the Eastern European States nominated Ion Jinga (Romania) to replace Simona Mirela Miculescu (Romania) in representing the regional group on the Bureau as Chair. In addition, following the resignation of Janina Hasse-Mohsine (Germany), the Western European and other States nominated Andreas Glossner (Germany) to replace her on the Bureau as Vice-Chair, and following the resignation of Do Hung Viet (Viet Nam), the Asia-Pacific States nominated Mohammad Hassani Nejad Pirkouhi (Islamic Republic of Iran) to replace him on the Bureau as Vice-Chair. At the opening meeting of the fifty-fourth session of the Commission, on 3 February 2016, the three nominees will be elected as Chair and Vice-Chairs, respectively. At the same meeting, the Commission will designate one of its Vice-Chairs as also having rapporteurial responsibilities.

2. Adoption of the agenda and other organizational matters

Rule 7 of the rules of procedure requires that, after the election of its officers at the beginning of each session, the Commission shall adopt the agenda for that session on the basis of the provisional agenda. The provisional agenda and documentation for the fifty-fourth session of the Commission were approved by the Economic and Social Council in its decision 2015/212.

The proposed organization of work of the Commission at its fifty-fourth session (see annex I) has been prepared pursuant to relevant decisions of the General Assembly and the Economic and Social Council to facilitate the consideration of agenda items within the time frame available and in accordance with the conference services allocated to the Commission. The timetable should be considered tentative and indicative: if the Commission completes its consideration of an item ahead of schedule, it may wish to proceed immediately to the next item.

The Commission is scheduled to meet from Wednesday, 3 February, to Friday, 12 February 2016. Arrangements have been made to hold morning and afternoon meetings during the session: morning meetings will be held from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and afternoon meetings from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.

The Commission reviewed the theme in 2015 at its fifty-third session and will complete the biennial cycle by adopting action-oriented policy recommendations on rethinking and strengthening social development in the contemporary world at its fifty-fourth session, in 2016. The Commission will have before it the report of the Secretary-General on the priority theme.
