### **Organization of the session**

#### A. Opening and duration of the session

1. The Commission on Population and Development held its forty-seventh session at United Nations Headquarters on 26 April 2013 and from 7 to 11 April 2014. The Commission held \_\_\_\_ meetings (1st to \_\_\_\_).

7. At the same meeting, the Chair designated the Vice-Chairs, Jens Ole Bach Hansen (Denmark) and Nino Shekriladze (Georgia), to chair the informal consultations.

8. At the 3rd meeting, on 7 April 2014, a statement was made by the observer for the Plurinational State of Bolivia, on behalf of the Group of 77 and China.<sup>1</sup>
