

High-level segment - Item 5

Ministerial meeting of the high-level political forum on sustainable development, convened under the auspices of the Economic and Social Council - Item 5 (a)

The Vice-President of the Council (Norway) opened the meeting.

General debate

35th plenary meeting The President of the Council (Saint Vincent and the Grenadines) opened the meeting and made a statement.

High-level segment: High-level policy dialogue on future trends and scenarios and the long-term impact of current trends on the realization of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development - Item 5 (b)

The Council continued its consideration of the item and held an interactive discussion on the theme of the high-level segment, "Empowering people and ensuring inclusiveness and equality".

The discussion was moderated by the Executive Director of the Global Partnership for Sustainable Development Data, Claire Melamed, who made a statement.

Statements were made by the following resource persons: the Chair of the Committee of Experts on Public Administration, Geraldine Fraser-Moleketi; the Deputy Secretary-General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, Isabelle Durant; the Executive Director of the International Movement ATD Fourth World, Isabelle Pypaert-Perrin; the Senior Fellow and Director of Technology and Development at the Center for Global Development, Charles Kenny; and the Future Generations Commissioner for Wales, Sophie Howe.

Statements were also made by the following lead discussants: the Director of the Development Bureau of the International Telecommunication Union, Doreen Bogdan Martin; and the Executive President of Association Camerounaise pour la Prise en Charge des Personnes Âgées, Paulette Metang.

In the ensuing discussion, the resource persons and lead discussants replied to comments made and questions posed by the representatives of the United States, Mexico and Haiti, as well as by the observer for the Council of Europe.

The representative of the World Meteorological Organization participated in the discussion.
