The Committee resumed its consideration of the agenda item.

Support account for peacekeeping operations

The Assistant Secretary-General, Controller, Office of Programme Planning, Finance and Budget, introduced the reports of the Secretary-General on the budget performance of the support account for peacekeeping operations for the period from 1 July 2017 to 30 June 2018 (A/73/661 and A/73/661/Add.1), as well as the budget for the support account for peacekeeping operations for the period from 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2020 (A/73/793).

The attention of the Committee was drawn to the report of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee on the proposed budget of the Office of Internal Oversight Services under the support account for peacekeeping operations for the period from 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2020 (A/73/768), as well as to the statement by the Chairman of that Committee.

The Chair of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions introduced the related report of that Committee (A/73/849).
